Trione Vineyards and Winery

Overview

Three generations, four decades, five ranches — the Trione family is deeply rooted in the Sonoma County wine industry. Dedicated farmers for forty years, Mark and Vic Trione own and cultivate over 650 vineyard acres in three prime Sonoma County appellations: Russian River Valley, Alexander Valley and Sonoma Coast.

Sons of noted financier and philanthropist Henry Trione, Mark and Vic established Vimark, a management company during the 1970s. For decades, Vimark has provided prized grapes to prominent wineries in the North Coast region.

During 2005 a new chapter took root, Trione Vineyards and Winery. The family built a winery on their Home Ranch (Alexander Valley) and appointed Scot Covington winemaker. Asked to collaborate closely on the design of their new winery, Scot envisioned a straightforward facility, customized to accommodate small lots and hands-on winemaking. He made 2006 and 2007 vintages in a custom crush facility; the winery construction completed in time to receive the 2008 harvest.

Living a winemaker's dream, Scot selects just three percent of the Trione estate grapes and crafts small lots of wine in his customized "studio". Scot's goal: make wines that express the highest level of quality across all varieties: Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Sauvignon Blanc, Syrah and Zinfandel.

Winery operations are a family affair. Mark Trione is President, Vic is Vice President, Mark's daughter Denise oversees sales and marketing, and her husband, Kris Hicks, is Vineyard Operations Manager. Vic's son, V. Henry joined

the outside sales team in 2017 and oversees accounts in Sacramento, Tahoe, and Mendocino areas.

Trione winery is located next to their vintage 1908 landmark stone building at the Home Ranch in Alexander Valley. The family restored the Old Stone Building, preserving the history and authentic character. Now an event center, it is available for private parties and is the perfect space for an rustic elegant wedding. The tasting room and picnic area are open Thursday through Monday, 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM.
